





Terms & Conditions



The Hapori @ The Kiri Clinic is located in Wakefield Country Courtyard and is owned/managed by Terri Benamore. The Hapori has recently been fully refurbished and is a modern, accessible and inclusive venue with a capacity of up to 30 persons (standing).

The space has natural daylight and is heated. All bookings include complimentary WIFI, free on-site parking and use of the facilities which include disabled access/toilet facilities.

The competitively priced space has 3 rates to accommodate all bookings: Collaborative (partnership), Hosted Workshops (bought-in services), Hire The Hapori (Venue Hire)

Tea and coffee is available and catering can be provided on request (POA)

Enquiries for availability of a specific date can be provisionally held for 7 days from the date of enquiry. After this time if no booking form or deposit is received, the reservation will be cancelled.

Occasionally regular hirers may need to be cancelled for any reason that is deemed necessary. However, every effort will be made to keep these disruptions to a minimum.

1. The hire charges are set out in the event hire agreement. No reservations will be made without a deposit of £25 or 10% of the entire booking, whichever is higher required on booking (non-refundable). The balance must be paid within 1 week of the event taking place, however for the first event the balance must be paid in full 24 hours prior to the event taking place. Booking rates will be reviewed every calendar year.

2.A returnable deposit of £50 will be requested at time of booking, to cover any damages. This will be deducted from the final invoice where applicable.

3. The hirer will be responsible for the cost of making good any damage caused or of replacing any furniture or fittings lost or missing.

4.All breakages and any losses to the same shall be paid for by the hirer at the current replacement prices.

5. The hirer must leave the event space in a clean and tidy state. Cleaning materials are available. Failure to comply with this could result in the hirer paying additional costs for any cleaning.

6.The hirer shall be responsible for the proper conduct of persons using the meeting space. Should any person cause annoyance or inconvenience to other persons the hirer shall take all necessary steps to deal with the offender.

7. The venue will not, under any circumstances, accept responsibility or liability in respect of any damage to, or loss of, any property left upon the premises by the hirer.

8. The venue must not be used for the performance of any copyright works unless the hirer holds a licence issued by the appropriate body.


9.In order to ensure compliance with the terms of the premises licence and to prevent disturbance to residents living close the hirer must ensure that no music is played after 10pm. All bookings involving music are accepted on the condition that such music is played at a reasonable volume. Hirers are required to advise performers of this.

10. The hirer shall not transfer this booking to any other person or organisation.

11. The hirer must not leave belongings or equipment on the premises without consent of the venue and where this has been obtained, such items are left at the owners' risk.



Terms & Conditions





If the hirer cancels the booking, the non refundable deposit will be retained, unless the event space is re-let on the particular date in which case the deposit will be returned to the hirer. The venue reserves the right to cancel or refuse any booking if in its opinion this proves to be necessary. If any booking is cancelled by the venue will not be liable to pay compensation to any person in respect of such cancellation.

Cancellation timeframe

Cancellation cost < 7 days prior to the event 100%

14 – 8 days prior to event 50%

31 – 15 days prior to event 25%

More than 31 days prior to event 0%

HEALTH AND SAFETY

In order to ensure compliance with the terms of the premises licence no electrical appliance, PA system, CD player, disco equipment shall be used by any hirer or third party brought in by the hirer, unless it is PAT tested (portable appliance tested). No alterations or additions shall be made to the premises, including electric power supplies or lighting fitments without the written consent of the venue.

The hirer must notify the venue at the time of booking of any factor which involves fire risk and undertake their own risk assessment.

The hirer must have insurance for the nature of the event being held (for example public liability insurance).

Fire exits must be kept clear at all times. Please read the safety regulations displayed and ensure all those attending are aware of the fire evacuation procedure at the start of the event.

Children under 18 are only permitted if accompanied by a responsible adult.

The venue cannot accept responsibility for any injury, loss or damage suffered by the hirer or any persons attending the event if such loss or damage or injury is caused by the hirer or any persons themselves or by equipment brought into the building by the hirer or 3rd party.

It is the responsibility of the hirer to provide all first aid equipment for their event.
